Dear Parent or Guardian:

Although your child graduated at the conclusion of the 2019-2020 school terms, as a student with a disability, he or she might be entitled to compensatory services to address possible disruptions in his or her education resulting from the emergency closure of schools on March 13.

“Compensatory services” are special education and related services designed to help students recoup skills that might have regressed during the closures. Eligibility for these services is determined by your child’s IEP team based on its assessment of whether and to what extent he or she regressed during the last nine weeks of school. Every student is different, of course, and not every student will qualify for “compensatory services.” You and your child, as members of the IEP team, would participate in any discussion of skill regression and of the services needed, if any, to recoup any lost ground.

If you would like to discuss “compensatory services” further, or if you are interested in participating in an IEP team to discuss whether your child is eligible for these services and, if he or she is, what those services would consist of, do not hesitate to contact me at 267-599-2011.

If we do not hear from you, we will assume that you are not interested in “compensatory services” for your child, and we wish you and your child all the best.
